



## 2020 Scholarship Application

- ✓ Applicant must be a female and a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States
- ✓ Applicant must be a full-time student (rising undergraduate junior or senior, or graduate student) for the upcoming academic semester
- ✓ Applicant must be a resident of one of the following cities/counties: Chesapeake, Hampton, Newport News, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk, Virginia Beach, Accomack, North Hampton, James City County, Surry, Gloucester, York County, Isle of Wight, Williamsburg or Poquoson, or attend college or university in one of those cities/counties
- ✓ Applicant must have maintained a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- ✓ Applicant's area of study or declared major must be in one of the following Qualified Fields of Commercial Real Estate ("CRE"):

**APPLICATION COMPONENTS:**

1. Completed application form.
2. At least one (1) letter of recommendation from either a professor or a professional within a Qualified Field of CRE.
3. Proof of current full-time student enrollment. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the selected student's institution to be applied to pre-determined costs.
4. Electronic transcripts obtained directly from the registrar's office at each institution where applicant is currently enrolled, and from any other college or university applicant has attended, showing all undergraduate and postgraduate coursework completed in the last three years, including applicant's Fall 2019 grades.
5. Personal Essay on Leadership (500 words or less).
